NURSERY 30 HOURS FREE CHILDCARE

From September 2017 we have been offering 30 hours childcare for the families who are eligible.

In order to qualify for this free of charge, both parents must each expect to earn on average at least £120 a week.

This is equal to 16 hours at the national minimum or living wage. If one parent is on maternity, paternity or adoption leave or they are unable to work because they are disabled or have caring responsibilities, they may still be eligible.

FREE SCHOOL UNIFORM VOUCHERS - MILK - FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Please check if you are eligible to receive any of the above. Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and receives the Universal Free Meal brought in by the Government, you still need to apply to receive the vouchers and milk.

If your family receives Income Support, Income based job seekers allowance, Pension credit (Guarantee credit), Employment and support allowance (Income support), Child tax credit (but not working tax credit) or Universal credit call into the school office and complete a form, you will need your National Insurance number. We will be pleased to check for you. Or check online at www.bradford.gov.uk/schoolmeals and complete the online form. If you qualify, you will receive all of the above until 2022.

NURSERY AND RECEPTION PLACES 2019

We have places available in our Nursery and Reception classes for September 2019. Please speak to your friends and family with children of school age about our school.
